President's Report

Most of us on the first New York Servant Bus rode the Cyclone.

But even if you didn't ride the real Cyclone, 2009 was a wild, rough, bone-jarring thrilling year for us at Camp of the Cross. Our weather, alone, was a wild ride. We began the year in wild weather and we ended the year in wild weather.

And between, all sorts of things happened. First of all, we struggled with our finances for much of the year. In March, the Board took the action of eliminating a staff position. In September we took out an operating loan and sent out an urgent request for additional funds. The staff stepped up and covered a number of additional duties to help with the budget crunch.

Yet, while there were very difficult times and decisions, the constituency responded tremendously in our Fall appeal. Your giving was so strong that we ended the year more financially sound than ever. Thank you for your response.

Programmatically, we had a very strong year. Our retreat and summer programming went very well. The Servant Buses to New York had a tremendous experience. We, of course, have room to grow. We continue to work with congregations and individuals to encourage youth and adults to experience the Camp. We continue to provide a variety of experiences.

Our staff has been reconfigured this year. Our long-time office manager, Sally Nordquist, retired. Assistant director for youth ministries, Wade Messer, and assistant director for adult ministries, Amy Hansen, moved on to other opportunities. Mary Ann Narum and Margie Nelson, our gifted retreat cooks, retired after many years of service. Mandi Britton is our new office manager. Jared Rendell is our new program director. Anna Rendell is our new part time retreat director. All of these new staff members have added a great deal of enthusiasm and excitement. Ben Hamilton had his hands full this fall as the site manager having to deal with failing water lines. And Janis Sloka is doing an outstanding job as executive director – even though he still has that Pennsylvania accent. Of course, the summer programming could not remain strong without the simply excellent summer staff that share their lives with the Camp.

As we enter into 2010, the Board of Directors continues to work with Janis to strengthen the financial situation of the Camp. The Board is also working with Mark Burkhardt, ELCA Director for Youth Ministries, in a strategic planning process.

I want to thank all of our volunteers who help make the ministry of the Camp what it is. Thank you to the congregations, groups and individuals who have generously responded to our financial situation. Thank you to all the staff for your hard work.

What a wild ride 2009 has been. Yes, a wild, rough, bone-jarring ride, but thrilling, too. I can't wait for 2010!

Program Report

Greetings, CCM board of directors and constituent churches! Blessings to you in the new year. 2009 has been a year of transition and growth for Camp of the Cross Ministries, and those changes included us coming on staff this past summer. Jared began at CCM in July, and Anna joined him in late August. We feel blessed to be here, and have slowly but SURELY been adjusting to life on the prairie. ☺ Truly, we believe God called and led us to Camp of the Cross and we intend to continue responding to that call in our new life here. The people of

Garrison, the staff and board of CCM have been nothing but welcoming, kind, and hospitable. Thank you.

Though we can't give a firsthand report of the year before July, the second half of the 2009 program year has been exciting. As we closed out the summer, after ministering to hundreds of youth and their leaders, the summer staff of about 40 left camp exhausted yet refreshed and ready to serve God on their campuses and in their communities. Starting immediately in September, the retreat season kicked into high gear - Anna will offer more detail about the retreat program area in the next paragraph. This fall and winter, I have been working on CCM's publications, designing the all-new summer brochure and also a postcard that outlines all summer programs. Summer recruiting is in full swing - applications are coming in, and in February we will begin traveling to schools for recruiting.

Like Jared said, retreat programs are in full swing! This fall and winter, my weekends were jam-packed with retreat goers. Scrapbookers and artists, 90+ for a women's retreat, a group of young adults from the Minot Air Force Base, a published quilter leading workshops for the Garrison quilt guild, youth at our Fall Bash, Dickens Festival guests, confirmation groups, and more have gathered at Camp of the Cross for spiritual renewal, refreshment and fun. To save money, the year round staff served as retreat cooks until January, when Carter Hill began as retreat cook. CCM continues to be booked for retreats through the rest of the year, including summer family reunions. There is lots of scheduling, preparing, planning, and promoting going on right now. I am also spending time talking with new potential retreat groups, families, and individuals in the hopes of giving more people an opportunity to grow in faith through CCM.

There will be a new CCM website up very soon. We have also begun using Twitter, Facebook, and Cam-pography to communicate with campers, current and potential staff. We ordered new Jacob's Well items (sweatshirts, hats, sweatpants and t-shirts) and they have been selling really well.

We are excited to be pursuing goals for Camp of the Cross. We'll be offering new programs next summer, including senior high on-site camp, on-site day camps, camp for individuals with disabilities, advanced fishing camp and sports camp. Next year, we'll include more retreats for youth, and will continue working with the synod to offer more programs for junior high youth specifically. We are also looking into new and creative ways to promote CCM through social media, publications and face-to-face conversations. 2009 has been a great year for camp, and 2010 promises to be even better!

Office Manager Report Mandi Britton

What a great change this has been for me. Who wouldn't like a view of the lake everyday at work? Since beginning in May, I have enjoyed coming to work and seeing how generous people are as they donate their time, talents, and hard earned money to be sure that this camp has all it needs. I have to thank my long list of volunteers that help me in the office with the monthly newsletter and addressing thank you notes, as well as the every day things to help me keep the office running smoothly.

This past summer we had over 600 campers come to Camp of the Cross, and another 200 that attended day camps at their own churches. We are gearing up for another summer camp season by hiring staff, sending out summer schedules, and working to get online registration up and going.

The date for the 2010 Prairie Lake Festival is June 26th. Let's hope for better weather this year to make it the most successful year ever.

I look forward to another great year at camp. I enjoy working with our staff and am excited for our rearrangement in the office that will bring Jared and Anna's office to the main office building. This will help trying to track people down by having a centralized work area. Thank you for the opportunity to work at Camp of the Cross. I have truly enjoyed my time here so far, and look forward to many more years.

Site Report Ben Hamilton

I am excited to share with you how God has moved in this place over this past year. Most of this movement has been done through many volunteers and donation, thank you if you were a part of this.

Last year started with some remodeling in the Wellness Center. A kitchenette was added into the apartment, along with expanding the overall size by adding a living room. Although the entire apartment received a new coat of paint and looks amazing, the kitchen cabinets are my favorite addition. These cabinets were crafted by donation and craftsmanship of board member Bob Lussenden. Alongside the "apartment" remodel was the building of bathrooms in our storm shelter and staff lounge area. These bathrooms prevented a lot of worry each time the storm shelter was utilized.

Early in the summer, summer staff members started painting the chapel. It turned out to be a longer project than any estimation but the results were outstanding. Also added this summer was a 40'x60' garden. Thanks to a grant from the ELCA the garden was used and implemented into a environmental education program here at camp. Combined with the upgrades and cleaning of the chapel, it was exciting to see these "new" spaces added for the summer program.

Painting became popular upkeep this summer as paint donators came forward. In addition to the chapel, four other buildings were able to get a new face. The buildings included are the three retreat center cabins and the site house. I cannot express my thanks enough to those who helped with these preventative maintenance projects and/or donated paint/stain.

It was a very exciting year for those who enjoy Lake Sakakawea. Rising over 20ft higher at its peak than last year, the lake has a renewed beauty. Higher water elevations called for a couple of transformations here at camp. First, our water front (swimming) area was moved again, further north into the bay. The water front now has a nice gentle slope and is north of boat ramp traffic! Speaking of boat ramps, the Army Corps of Engineers approved and installed a new high water boat ramp! The new ramp has a more gentle slope and is wider than the original high water boat ramp.

Camp of the Cross benefited by receiving needed concrete work, done by those contracted for the ramp. Schmidt Construction donated time, knowledge and equipment use to complete accessibility walkways to our main office and retreat center cabin.

As summer came to an end, work did not end as a water break was noticed. The water break is quite possibly the biggest headache since I started here. Due to a lack of documenting underground lines and no curb stops it was a grand challenge to isolate where the water was going astray. In the end, two separate breakage areas were found. A new line was brought into the dining hall and the women's restroom received a facelift due to the new plumbing. Currently, the men's room is also undergoing a new remodeling. A huge thank you to Ditch Witch of Bismarck including Alton Larson and Gordy Nord for their help in donations and equipment operation to replace the old lines. Among many others, Scott Schonauer of Garrison deserves recognition for his many hours of help throughout the project. As Spring comes it is our plan to have curb stops added to several areas of the water system to prevent such a loss in the future. I am also currently working on developing an updated and master map of all buried utilities for future reference. Combined, maps and curb stops will save many hours of guess work offering more efficient solutions to problems that may arise.

A very welcome anonymous gift was given this fall. A 2000 Ford Ranger was donated to camp with very low miles and all maintenance completed. I am very excited this winter to have a street legal truck with heat to use! I am certain this truck will have years of usage here at camp.

I look forward moving into another year and finding new challenges along the way (although I prefer it not be a water break)! YOU are what makes this ministry happen. Without your support little could get done. I thank you for this support and express gratitude to the dozens of faithful volunteers who have given a hand. Together, we are able to create and maintain a place of opportunity to "Camp with Christ...For Lives of Faith"!

Page 2

II. Purpose

A. To establish and maintain a facility known as Camp of the Cross Ministries for the furtherance of Christian growth among (people of all generations.) (Delete remainder of paragraph.)

Page 3

IV. Memberships

ELCA congregations who participate in the Camp program or which are within the designated CCM area of the Synod are considered a constituent congregation. If such Lutheran congregation desires to be added or taken off the constituent list, they may do so by having an official representative contact the Camp's Board of Directors, requesting such a change. (Non-ELCA congregations may be admitted into membership of the corporation by a two-thirds {2/3} majority vote of the delegates at any annual or special meeting of the corporation. The constituency shall maintain a 2/3 majority ELCA membership.) (delete ELCA) Congregations which are on the Camp of the Cross Ministries constituent list shall be entitled to send three {3} voting members and their pastors, who also have vote, to the annual meeting.

Page 3

VI. Board of Directors

The Corporate powers, business and property of the corporation shall be exercised, conducted and controlled by a Board of Directors consisting of {at least 12} individuals from constituent congregations. There shall be a minimum of three {3} clergy on the board. (The board shall maintain a 2/3 ELCA majority membership.) All members of the Board of Directors.....

Page 3 VI. B. Meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held (remove monthly and change to quarterly), or as required.....

Page 3 VI. Add D. Treasurer. The Board of Directors shall appoint a treasurer, who may or may not be a member of the Board. The treasurer shall serve a one year term and may be appointed to no more than 5 consecutive terms. The treasurer shall oversee receipts and expenditures of the Corporation. The treasurer, in conjunction with the office manager and Executive Director, shall give a monthly report to the Board of Directors.
